Fleurieu Poultry Association Update

A public meeting was held on Monday 1st December. The purpose of the gathering was to seek support for the establishment of community co-operative to maintain a poultry processing facility at the Aldinga Turkeys site at McLaren Flat that Ingham's has announced it is closing on 19th December.

At the meeting Leon Bignell, the Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries advised that the government would fund a feasibility study for the co-operative which means the proposed project is still alive. A facility of this kind on the Fleurieu Peninsula would be significant for the farming sector. At this stage there is no significant poultry industry on the Peninsula due to lack of processing.

Exhibition - Breakaway versus Peleton by Elinor Alexander

This series of paintings celebrates the many cold late nights and early mornings spent by Australian cycling fans watching Le Tour de France over 3 weeks amidst the Antipodean winter. It also celebrates McLaren Vale's link between cycling and brilliant wine as it continues to host the Tour Down Under's most critical stage, which takes place close to Fox Creek and features the Willunga Hill climb. There are a series of abstracted micro-landscapes included in this exhibition, they are all hilly and reflect some of the more Alpine topography of cycling. South Australian based artist, Elinor Alexander, is a keen cyclist who has followed Le Tour for many years. Elinor has studied painting and drawing part time at the Adelaide Central School of Arts and regularly takes ACSA master classes and courses. A geologist by trade, she is fascinated by landscapes and what lies beneath.
