The Product

Nine varieties of apples, ten varieties of pears, and cherries, peaches, plums, nectarines, apricots and asparagus. Mangos and avocados are in the pipeline.

Tracing the hands

Mark & Lisa are hands-on farmers. The soil is remineralised with colloidal rock minerals and they only use organic fertilizers with minimal or no spray.
